

INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE OF AUCKLAND PHD SCHOLARSHIP IN PLANT SCIENCES

REGULATIONS:

1. The Scholarship shall be known as the International College of Auckland PhD Scholarship in Plant Sciences.
2. One Scholarship will be awarded, for a period of three years, and will be of the value of \$20,000 pa.
3. The Scholarship will be awarded to a PhD candidate in the field of plant science who has paid the fees, or arranged to pay the fees, for full-time enrolment in the School of Biological Sciences.
4. The Scholarship is tenable by Chinese students who are resident in one of the following areas of China at the time of application: Sichuan, Chongqing, Yunnan, Guizhou and Qinghai.
5. The basis of selection will be academic results in the relevant pre-requisite degree for PhD entry and potential to contribute to the field of plant science.
6. The Scholarship will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of a Selection Committee comprising the Dean of the Faculty of Science (or nominee), the Director of the School of Biological Sciences (or nominee) and one representative of the Donor (appointed by The International College of Auckland).
7. The Scholarship's emolument will be paid as a tuition/compulsory fees credit and the balance as a fortnightly stipend.
8. The Scholarship may be concurrently held with any other award or grant as long as a) the terms of that award or grant permit and b) the University of Auckland Council is informed and approves.
9. The University of Auckland Council, in consultation with the Donor, has the power to terminate or suspend a Scholarship if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a Scholar from the Director of the School of Biological Sciences.
10. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if in any year there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
11. The University of Auckland has the power to amend or vary these Regulations, in consultation with the Donor, provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.
12. Applications by way of a form, CV and at least two academic letters of reference close with the Scholarships Office on 1 October.

Notes:

- (i) Tuition / Compulsory fees are those related only to the relevant programme of study, plus Student Services Fee and Building Levy.

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS OF APPLICATION**

1. The information requested in the application form will be used for assessment purposes. All personal information collected during the application process may be made available to members of the Selection Committee for the particular award.
2. The Scholarships Office undertakes to store all applications in a secure place and to disclose the information requested in the application form only to those persons involved in the selection of candidates.
3. The Scholarships Office will normally hold documents about successful applicants for the period of the award. Documents for unsuccessful applicants will normally be kept for six weeks after the award has been made and then destroyed. Unsuccessful candidates may request that their materials, other than information supplied by a third party (see 5 below), be returned to them, rather than be destroyed. The request must be made within one month of the announcement of the award.
4. Consistent with the provisions of the Privacy Act applicants have the right of access to information held about them. Applicants also have the right to request the correction of information held about them.
5. Information about an applicant from other parties, e.g. personal reference, which is supplied by a referee or other person on a confidential basis, will not be made available to the applicant.
6. In order to honour successful applicants the Scholarships Office may disclose limited information (typically the award, your name and field of study) about successful applicants to the sponsor of the award, the University of Auckland Council, Graduation office, Calendar office, The University Society, External Relations office and Faculties. If your application is successful, by signing this form you have authorised the University to release limited details to the parties mentioned above. If for any reason information about you cannot be released as indicated, you must complete the portion of the declaration (see 9 below) provided for this. In some cases a candidate may be ineligible for an award if the personal information required cannot be made available to persons outside the University.
